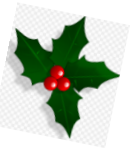

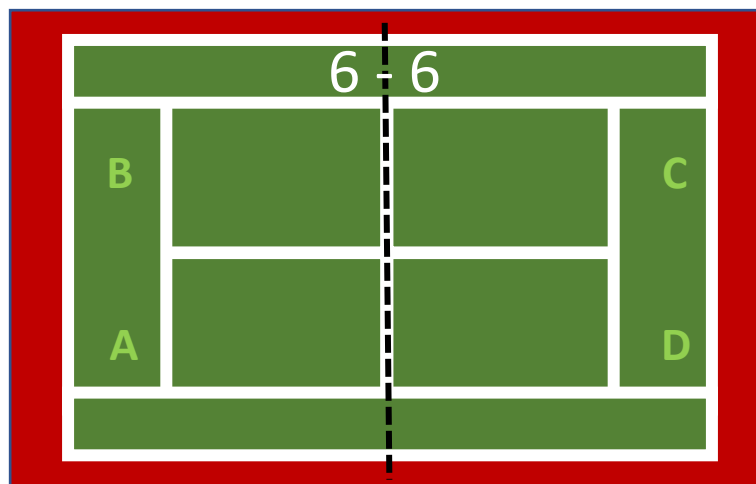
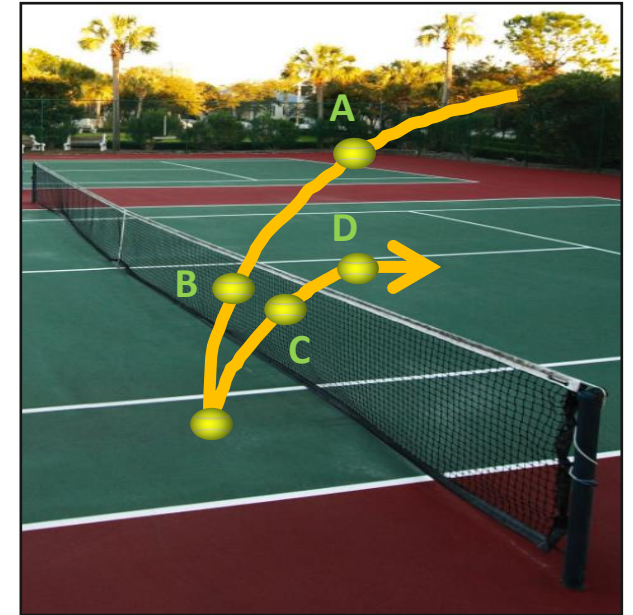

  - d) The teams change ends after every 6 points have been played

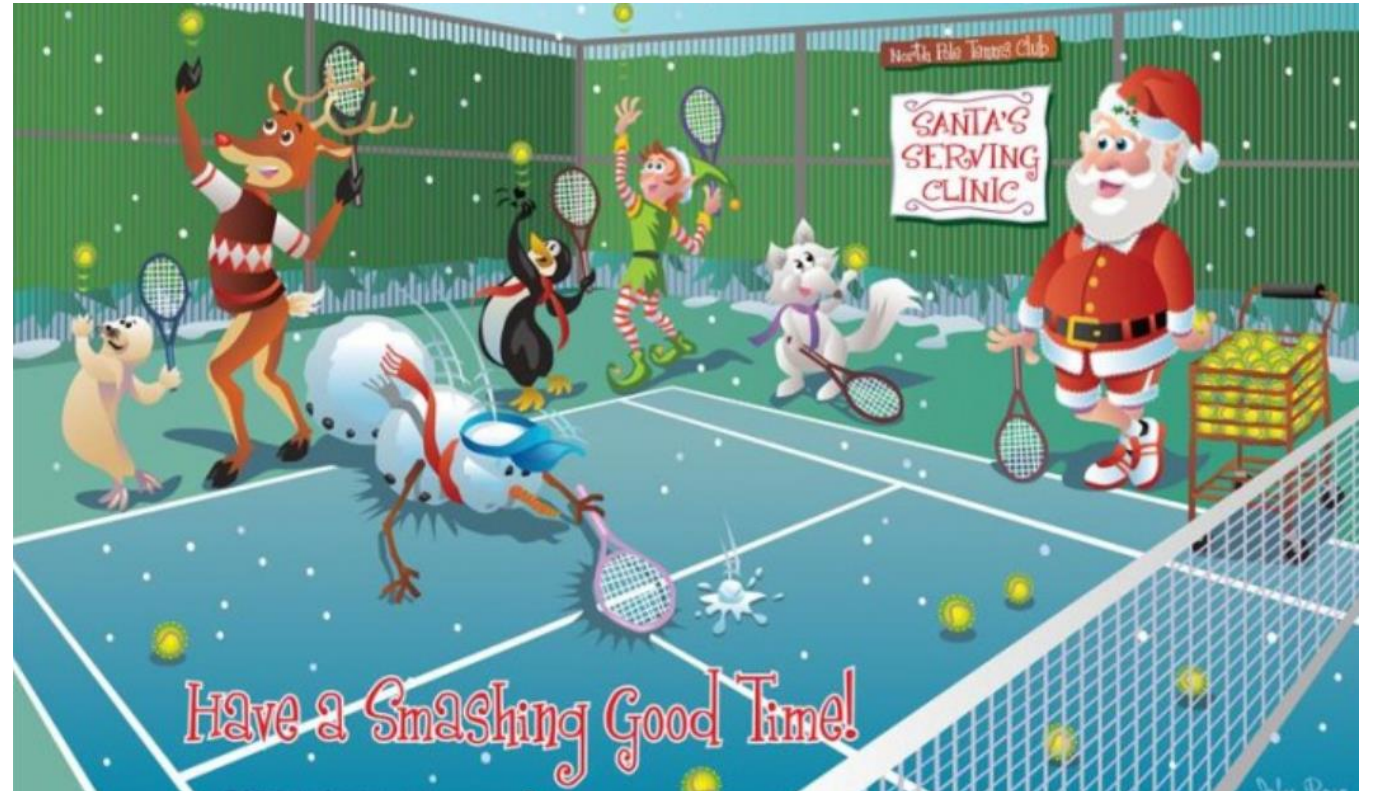
